ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Nominated Trainees must be currently enrolled as one of the following:

1. First or second year fellow in an adult endocrine training program (Priority given to first year fellows)
2. A graduate student in a Ph.D. granting program
3. A basic-science postdoctoral fellow
4. A second or third year fellow in a pediatric endocrine training program

Participants who attended the program in previous years are not eligible to apply for the Class of 2009 program.

All nominees must be members of The Endocrine Society. If the nominee is not a member of the Society, they must apply for membership before the January 31 nomination deadline.

GUIDELINES

- Applicants should not register for **ENDO 09** until after March 13, 2009.
- Selected trainees will be responsible for making their own travel arrangements.
- Selected trainees must attend the entire Endocrine Trainee Day.
