Nomination Deadline: March 21, 2007

The Fellows & Student Day Workshop has been created by The Endocrine Society to further meet the needs of endocrine trainees. It presents the unique opportunity for clinical fellows, graduate students and postdoctoral fellows to discuss the breadth of endocrinology with their peers and the leaders in the field.

This workshop provides valuable trainee education in both basic and clinical tracks. The Basic Track will include leading researchers presenting exciting new technologies, personal experiences, tips on choosing a post-doc, job opportunities, and much more. The Clinical Track will include thought leaders presenting perspectives on the diagnosis and treatment of endocrine disorders, advice on setting up a private practice, and strategies for achieving a healthy balance between career and personal life. The nomination deadline is March 21, 2007.

Trainees selected to attend the workshop will receive complimentary registration to ENDO 07 and up to \$500 in airfare reimbursement. Additionally, trainees are allowed up to \$100 in hotel reimbursement to help offset the cost of an additional hotel night to attend the workshop.
