Important Information:

1. 12 issues per year plus supplements are published for the three primary journals of The Endocrine Society (Journal of Clinical Endocrinology & Metabolism, Endocrinology, and Molecular Endocrinology). Endocrine Reviews publishes 7 issues per year (bi-monthly plus a special May issue). Subscriptions includes access to the electronic archive dating to 1997. Print subscriptions includes online access. Online-only access is available. Additional print subscriptions are also available.

2. Prices quoted are in US dollars and are effective immediately. Payments must be made in US dollars and checks must be drawn on a US bank. Subscribers please add appropriate sales, GST, and VAT taxes. Prices are subject to change at any time.

3. The publisher offers a 5% discount on each paid order to recognized subscription agents. Orders from subscription agents must specify the customer's "ship-to" information, for purposes of verifying the type of institution.

4. Agent must collect subscription fee based on quoted tier and rate and must get approval from The Endocrine Society to change tier or rate.

5. Requests for missing issues from US subscribers will only be honored between one and four months of the issue date and for International subscribers, between two and five months of the issue date.

The Endocrine Society's Description of Tiers

All tier assignments are subject to review by Endocrine Society staff. Factors including number of FTEs and usage will be considered.

Tier 1 – Small Institutions: Primary/secondary school, private practice office or private clinic, residency program, general reference public library, museum, or non-profit administrative office.

Tier 2 – Small Offices, Colleges, General Research/Reference or Charitable Institution: Community, technical, or associates level higher education colleges; institutes of technology, undergraduate or Masters level college/university, nursing school or allied health training program, seminaries, community hospital or clinic (no research), health policy or advocacy non-profit office/charitable organization, independent research library, small non-profit or government laboratory; professional society or trade union/industry trade association, local or regional government agency/ministry.

Tier 3 – Core Research Organizations/Institutes: Doctorate-granting research university, medical or pharmacy school, teaching or research hospital, private, non-profit research institute, small for-profit independent company, partnership, or organization. Must be single campus/site.

Tier 4 – Large, Regional, Networked Single Organizations: Multi-site single academic institution, private non-profit research organization or Healthcare network, large non-profit/government research institute or national government agency, mid-size for-profit organization.

Tier 5 – Very Large Institutions or Groups of Institutions. Major high usage institutions.
