Dr. Cooper is also a professor of medicine at Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine; director of the Division of Endocrinology at Sinai Hospital; and director of the Thyroid Clinic at Johns Hopkins Hospital in Baltimore, Maryland.

Dr. Nathan is one of the world's leading clinical investigators and educators in the field of diabetes. He was one of the architects of the Diabetes Control and Complications Trial (DCCT) and is chairman of the Diabetes Prevention Program and co-chair of the DCCT/EDIC study; both programs are funded by the National Institutes of Health. Dr. Nathan is also a professor of medicine at Harvard Medical School; director of the General Clinical Research Center and director of the Diabetes Center at Massachusetts General Hospital.
